A LETTER FROM THE CHAIRMAN

Dear friends,

Education Together Foundation established a new milestone during fiscal year 2010-11, as our assets surpassed the \$1,000,000 mark, standing at \$1.093 million as of June 30, 2011. Asset growth resulted from a combination of grants received, gifts from our generous donors, and market growth of the Foundation’s endowment. Individual and corporate donors provided more than \$47,000 in fiscal year 2010-11, the Chichester-duPont Foundation granted ETF \$40,000 for adult education programs, and the endowment fund enjoyed more than a 20% return on investment during the period, although investment growth slowed to less than 1% during the final quarter of the fiscal year.

Our traditional Awards Night took place on May 17, 2011 at the new First Baptist Church in Junction City. A total of \$63,000 in scholarships and grants was awarded at this event, going to 49 deserving students and numerous community educational organizations. In addition, ETF awarded \$4,700 in Chichester-duPont Adult Career Education grants to local adults seeking job-specific training during the spring of 2011.

Seven new funds were established by ETF during the fiscal year, including two new endowments (see the story below). Endowment Scholarship Funds are created when a donor contributes \$10,000 plus fees. Annual Scholarship Donations are given yearly by individuals or businesses to award one or more annual scholarships in a specific amount. ETF now has 30 endowment funds invested with OCF, and 28 annual Scholarship and Memorial funds.

We’re very proud of ETF, and look forward to a bright future. – Gary Nelson

NEW FUNDS INAUGURATED

Seven new scholarship funds were established in FY 2010-11.

A \$40,000 grant from the Chichester-duPont Foundation established the **Adult Career Education Endowment**, and the **Adult Career Education Fund**. The latter grant of \$20,000 will be used through mid-2013 to award adult education grants, while the endowment’s investment returns will fund future aid to adult students.

The **Jim Pitney Memorial Endowment** was established by the Pitney Family, with the intent of awarding an annual scholarship to a student intending to study agriculture at OSU. Its first award was made in May, 2011.

The **Mary Metts Memorial Scholarship** was

initiated by Curtis T Metts, and will award a scholarship to an OSU student, preferably one majoring in engineering. The first award was made in May, 2011.

Betty Moyer began the **Jack Moyer Memorial Scholarship** fund in December, 2010, and awarded the first scholarship in May, 2011.

Old School Vineyard & Wine Co. owners Stephen & Niki Hagen inaugurated their new scholarship fund in April, 2011, and also awarded a scholarship in May.

The **Cleve Dumdi Memorial Fund** was launched in the late spring of 2011, and as of June 30 had received nearly \$5,000 in contributions.

In 1999, dedicated ETF Board Member Pam Fiske (class of 1974) was instrumental in the formation of the Tiger Alumni Fund Endowment. Over 700 alumni, parents and grandparents, along with proceeds from golf tournaments, have provided more than \$141,000 to this fund.

Since 2000, the Tiger Alumni Fund has given 47 scholarships to students who are the children of JCHS alumni.

In 2011, the Tiger Alumni Fund awarded three \$1000 scholarships, to **Rachel Barnes** (father Bryon Barnes ('82)); **McKenzie Francois** (father Damon

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS & PROJECTS AWARDS

The Starns FFA Endowment presented an award of \$1000 to the JCHS FFA Program.

ADULT CAREER EDUCATION GRANTS

Funds available through the Chichester-DuPont Foundation grant for Adult Career Education were used to provide \$4700 in grants to four students and to the JC Community Service Center. The

grant to the Center supported English as a Second Language instruction for ten local citizens. The four student grants were for nursing, cosmetology, pharmacy and paramedic training. Grants are aimed at

adults seeking to enhance their career potential through practical training. Further grants will be awarded to qualified applicants through June, 2013.

COMMUNITY AND SCHOOL GRANT AWARDS

The ETF Community and School Grant Endowment was established in 2002, and has been funded primarily through grants from the Chichester-DuPont Foundation, although individuals have contributed to this endowment as well.

Grant funds of \$6500 have been earmarked for awards to be made in the 2011-12 fiscal year. The funds will be allocated to community agencies such as the Junction City Public Library, Viking Sal Senior Center, Junction City Community Center, Habitat for Humanity

and ETF's Adult GED Program. School grants will be allocated among Territorial and Laurel Elementary Schools, Oaklea Middle School and JC High School in 2011-2012.

These funds are invested with The Oregon Community Foundation; investment earnings are used to fund scholarships and to increase the fund's equity.

Annual Scholarship Donations are given yearly by individuals or businesses for a specific amount, to fund one or more annual scholarships. An annual administrative fee of \$50 is charged for the first scholarship awarded from each fund, with a 2% fee for any additional scholarships in a given year.

Donations to any of these funds are welcomed.
